The provisional entry date has now past and we have a record number if entries. More information will follow as we get nearer to the event.

Entry dates

Provisional by **28th April 2009 [expired]**
Definitive by 29th June 2009
Nominative by 7th September 2009

Competition 1 – qualifiers for individual finals
Competition 2 – individual finals [Balance and Dynamic]
Competition 3– All round final – combined plus scores from competition 1 [Balance and Dynamic]

Federations may enter 2 pairs and groups in each category with the understanding that *only one in each category can proceed to a final.*

Federations are reminded that late entries may not be accepted or incur a high financial sanction

There will not be a team competition included in the 2009 Championships. A new event will be introduced in even years the first starting in 2010. Contact with probable organizers is now in hand and once the arrangements are finalize more information will follow through the UEG ACRO Newsletter.

Tariff Sheets

Because of the exceptional high number of entries for the Championships we need to insist that tariff sheets are with organizers 48 hours

before the start of the competition, [FIG regulation 42.2]. It is strongly recommended that sheets are sent by e-mail attachment as transmission by fax sometimes distorts the text and drawings.

More reminders will follow s this is a very important issue.
